

ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS

Overview:

The IBS Advanced Diploma in Business (Accounting) requires successful completion of the first sixteen (16) units of the Bachelor of Business (Accounting) degree programme.

On completion of these sixteen units (16) units (second year), an Advanced Diploma in Business (Accounting) will be awarded by the Institute of Business Studies as per the licensing agreement with Southern Cross University (SCU), Australia.

Entry requirement:

- ✓ IBS Diploma in Business
- ✓ Other equivalent diplomas conferred by recognized Universities

Registration & Duration:

Registration is open all year round for February and July intake. Full time students can enrol for four units per semester to complete the course within one year.

Course fee:

AUD1,000 / unit on or before the course commencement date. Course fees must be paid in PNG Kina to the equivalent of AUD1,000 / unit.

Further studies / pathway:

Bachelor of Business offered in affiliation with Southern Cross University (SCU), Australia.

Accreditation:

Student membership into the Institute of Certified Practising Accountants (CPA) PNG

Accommodation:

IBS provides minimum accommodation on campus and space is guaranteed upon payment of the full accommodation fee. There are separate blocks for female and male students.
