

DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS

Overview:

The primary aim of the course is to equip students to understand business in general. The IBS Diploma in Business requires one-year of full-time or equivalent part-time study. On successful completion of this programme a certificate will be awarded by IBS in affiliation with Southern Cross University (SCU), Australia. It is important to note that this programme consists of the first eight (8) units of the Bachelor of Business Degree programme of Southern Cross University, Australia.

Entry requirement:

- ✓ Grade 10 with IBS Certificate in Accounting (CIA)
- ✓ Grade 12 or equivalent

Registration & Duration:

Registration is open all year round for February and July intake. Full time students can enrol for four units per semester to complete the course within one year.

Course fee:

K1, 900 / unit or 50% of course fee payable on enrolment and the balance 50% within five weeks of the commencement date.

Further studies / pathway:

IBS Advanced Diploma in Business offered in affiliation with Southern Cross University (SCU), Australia.

Specialisation

Students can choose either Accounting or Information Systems specialization during the second year.

Accommodation:

IBS provides minimum accommodation on campus and space is guaranteed upon payment of the full course and accommodation fee. There are separate blocks for female and male students.
